Dear Bob:

The STW Recycling System is working great for our phosphatising operation. We are already seeing our pond clearing up and have experienced a large decrease in waste water being discharged to the pond. In the past we were discharging 4,500 gallons of waste water per week and have reduced that too approximately 50 gallons per week. A savings here is hard to put a figure on as we get our water from a deep well making water cost minimal, but the clarity we are now seeing in the pond is everything we had hoped to see.

We are also seeing a substantial savings in chemical cost as we were using five gallons of Freemont 608 per day before and now have changed to the Secure Steam Ultra chemical and reduced the usage to one half gallon every other day. Even with the added cost of filters for this system versus our old method we are saving \$52.00 per week or over \$2,700.00 per year just in chemical.

Last and not least we have found that not only are we saving money every day but the metal treatment process is just as effective as our original spray to waste method and our pond is back to being the environmental accent we had intended for our facility.
